Palabras de la directora

Es difícil definir en pocas palabras el momento histórico que vive actualmente la humanidad. Por una parte, docenas de logros en diferentes ámbitos, demuestran la firme voluntad de los seres humanos para construir un mundo mejor. Por otra parte, catástrofes naturales imprevisibles han sembrado el dolor en muchos lugares del planeta; y los enfrentamientos entre pueblos por motivos religiosos, políticos, económicos y sociales señalan lo endeble que son las relaciones humanas y lo complejo que resulta establecer una sana y duradera convivencia entre las personas.

Pese a todo, como el fiel de una balanza y apreciando por igual problemas como éxitos, la Filosofía sigue siendo una herramienta extraordinaria para encontrar las raíces de los hechos, para hacer perdurar los valores y para buscar soluciones a los obstáculos.

El amor a la sabiduría nos permite interesarnos por todos los campos de acción, por todas las posibilidades que la naturaleza humana tiene a su alcance, a veces de manera explícita, a veces escondida a la espera de una ocasión para manifestarse. Los aparentes fracasos no desaniman al filósofo sino que, al contrario, mueven sus mejores energías para convertirlos en triunfos. El ánimo de búsqueda es siempre positivo. Y las victorias no lo envanecen ya que siempre existe algo más que aprender.

Con este espíritu de investigación y hallazgo, de aprendizaje y experiencia renovada, Nueva Acrópolis continúa su tarea que comenzó hace ya cuarenta y siete años, ofreciendo su aporte educativo, sus actividades culturales con contenido histórico de pasado y futuro, sus acciones sociales en expansión, su presencia editorial en diferentes países y lenguas y su vivencia filosófica que sobrepasa todas las fronteras, tendiendo lazos de fraternidad y esperanza.

Este Anuario es una pequeña muestra que ponemos en las manos de quienes, seguramente, comparten los mismos ideales de unión y sabiduría.

It is difficult to define, in so few words, the present historical moment which humanity is living. On the one hand, dozens of achievements in different fields demonstrate the firm will of human beings to build a better world. On the other hand, unforeseen natural catastrophes have sown the seeds of pain in many places around the planet; and the clashes among various peoples due to religious, political, economic, and social differences indicate weak human relations and complicate the establishment of a healthy and lasting human community.

Despite all these factors, like a set of scales which equally evaluates problems as well as successes, philosophy continues to be an extraordinary tool for getting to the root of facts, for making our values last, and for looking for solutions to obstacles. The love of wisdom allows us to become interested in all fields of action and in all the possibilities that human nature has within its grasp, sometimes in an explicit way, sometimes hidden and waiting for an opportunity to manifest itself. Apparent failures do not discourage the philosopher but, on the contrary, create the best energy to turn them into triumphs. The spirit of the search is always positive. Victories don't make the philosopher feel too proud, since there is always something more to be learned.

With this spirit of investigation and discovery and of learning and renewed experience, New Acropolis continues the work it started forty-seven years ago, offering educational contributions, cultural-historical activities relating to the past and the future, an expanding social action program, a publishing presence in many countries with their different languages, as well as personal philosophical experiences that exceed all boundaries, creating bonds of hope and brotherhood.

This yearbook is a small sample that we place in the hands of those who, surely, share the same ideals of unity and wisdom.




A través de sus publicaciones, Nueva Acrópolis difunde un nuevo espíritu filosófico con eclecticismo y apertura de planteamientos.

Anualmente se editan libros, revistas, periódicos, manuales de divulgación en más de 15 idiomas y sobre los más diversos campos del saber humano, resaltando la labor de recuperación de obras clásicas y la difusión de textos fundamentales en la Historia del Pensamiento. Nueva Acrópolis utiliza las nuevas tecnologías de la comunicación editando obras en soporte informático, y está presente en Internet mediante sus páginas web en varios idiomas que permiten a los internautas conocer sus novedades editoriales y extensa información cultural.

New Acropolis, through its publications with an eclectic choice of subjects and an open-minded approach, aims to promote a new philosophical spirit.

Books, magazines, newspapers and accessible research are published in more than 15 languages on a wide variety of topics. Special emphasis is placed on the recovery of classical works and publications of fundamental texts from the history of human thought.

New Acropolis makes use of new communication technologies by publishing works in electronic format. It also has a presence on the Internet via its web pages in several languages, allowing surfers to find its new publications and extensive cultural information.

Investigation Work

Nueva Acrópolis desarrolla un gran campo de actividades en el marco de la documentación.

Posee bibliotecas especializadas que reúnen alrededor de 400.000 volúmenes, videotecas y departamentos de audiovisuales de producción propia.

Realiza concursos de monografías y trabajos de investigación que se vuelcan en nuevas publicaciones, así como en cursos, seminarios y conferencias que integran los distintos programas de actividades culturales y las colaboraciones con Centros de estudios y Universidades.

Los departamentos de investigación constituidos en los diferentes países abordan trabajos sobre las materias que integran el plan de estudios, profundizando con rigor en aquellos aspectos en que el enfoque filosófico de Nueva Acrópolis puede aportar nuevas perspectivas.

New Acropolis carries out a wide range of activities in the field of documentation.

Its specialist libraries contain around 400,000 volumes. There are also video libraries and audiovisual production departments.

The results of essay competitions and research projects are then made available to the public in new publications. They are also used for courses, seminars and lectures and for joint projects with schools and universities.

The research departments in different countries pursue studies into the curriculum-related subjects, focusing on areas where the deep philosophical approach of New Acropolis can provide new perspectives.



NUEVA ACRÓPOLIS EN EL MUNDO NEW ACROPOLIS AROUND THE WORLD

Presente en más de 50 países, repartidos en todos los continentes, reúne miles de miembros activos y cientos de miles de simpatizantes, que se expresan en más de 15 lenguas y representan una amplia gama de herencias culturales, orígenes étnicos y creencias, ofreciendo un valioso ejemplo de convivencia y comprensión humana.

New Acropolis can be found in more than 50 countries, in five continents, and has thousands of active members and hundreds of thousand of sympathisers that communicate in more than 15 languages and represent a wide range of cultural inheritance, ethnic origins and belief of living together in total comprehension.



Resolución de la Asamblea General

Resolutions of the General Meeting

Celebrada el 8 de abril de 2004, en la ciudad de México D.F. (Mexico), se tomaron, entre otras, las siguientes resoluciones (es resumen):

- La Asamblea General manifiesta su voluntad de seguir colaborando con las líneas de acción propuestas por la Organización de las Naciones Unidas, con cuyos principios la OINA se identifica, con el fin de colaborar en alcanzar una sociedad más justa, tolerante y solidaria.
- La Asamblea General se hace eco, tal como lo ha destacado su Presidenta en recientes Encuentros de carácter regional, de las nuevas corrientes de pensamiento que, analizando la sociedad actual, han llamado la atención sobre nuevas interpretaciones de la realidad social. Parece que la sociedad se está volcando hacia lo que se ha denominado una "nueva Edad Media", en la cual será necesario aprender a reciclar los materiales existentes y crear modelos de "economía de crisis" que permitan subsistir a los seres humanos, en particular a los estratos más necesitados de la sociedad de nuestro tiempo. Esto se ha podido observar en las recientes crisis económicas de Argentina, México o el Sudeste Asiático, zonas donde la OINA tiene delegaciones que realizan una importante actividad de ayuda social.
- La Asamblea General reitera la importancia, ya señalada en Asambleas Generales anteriores, en las que se ha venido haciendo hincapié sobre la importancia de tener en cuenta el deterioro que está sufriendo el planeta Tierra, ya sea por la acción irresponsable de la mano del hombre o de las catástrofes naturales, que vienen asolando, en estos últimos tiempos, ciudades, poblaciones y el entorno ecológico, y las posibilidades que tiene la OINA de contribuir a paliar el dolor que producen estos desastres, llevando a cabo una concreta y puntual labor de acción en el marco de los modelos de voluntariado, ya sea por sí misma o en colaboración con otros organismos internacionales, públicos o privados, que trabajan en esta misma dirección.
- La Asamblea General de la OINA manifiesta sus condolencias a las víctimas de los atentados terroristas que están convulsionando al mundo y que se cobran innumerables vidas inocentes. En este sentido, desea hacer un llamamiento a la paz y al sentido común; recordar que esta violencia indiscriminada no lleva más que a una espiral de odio y fanatismo que provoca un nuevo tipo de guerra mundial de terror que arrastra a los seres humanos hacia comportamientos indignos que cercenan la libertad y la concordia. Por tal razón, la OINA apela, a través de sus asociaciones adherentes en todo el mundo, a realizar campañas que fomenten el diálogo y la tolerancia.

Todas las decisiones han sido aprobadas por unanimidad.

At the General Meeting in Mexico City (Mexico), held on 8 April 2004, the following resolutions, amongst others, were passed:

- The General Meeting declared its intention to continue to co-operate with the guidelines proposed by the United Nations, with whose principles IONA identifies, in order to help achieve a more just, tolerant and co-operative society.
- The General Meeting noted certain recent interpretations of the current social situation, as highlighted by its president of IONA at recent regional meetings. According to these, it seems that society is tending towards what has been called a "New Middle Ages", where it will be necessary to learn to recycle existing materials and develop ways of surviving in a "crisis economy", particularly in the most disadvantaged strata of society. This has been seen in the recent economic crises of Argentina, Mexico and Southeast Asia, areas where IONA has representative offices which play an important role in providing social assistance.
- The General Meeting reiterated the importance, already pointed out at previous General Meetings, of becoming aware of the damage being done to planet Earth, whether as a result of irresponsible actions by human beings or by natural catastrophes which have recently been devastating cities, towns and the environment.
- We have also seen IONA's ability to help alleviate the suffering brought about by these disasters, by carrying out volunteer actions on the ground, either on its own or in co-operation with other public and private international organisations working along the same lines.
- The General Meeting of IONA expressed its condolences to the victims of the terrorist attacks that are convulsing the world and taking countless innocent lives. In this sense, it wishes to issue a call for peace and common sense; to recall that this indiscriminate violence can only lead to a spiral of hatred and fanaticism that will give rise to a new kind of world war of terror, driving human beings to degrading types of behaviour which will reduce freedom and harmony. IONA therefore appeals to its member associations around the world to carry out campaigns to promote dialogue and tolerance.

All the resolutions were unanimously approved.


